ALKATAS was void of early speed then closed a gap late. BEST TRIP passed tiring rivals eight wide. REDWOOD MAN was hustled along but had no rally. GOLANI RULES chased to the stretch then faded. IMPORTUNO was hung four wide to the quarter pole then faded. CODE MONEY showed little.
