LEAZOVE broke sharp then was well handled setting the pace, drew off a bit leaving the second turn then had more than enough left to maintain a safe margin late. RAPID HALO was boxed to the stretch, swung out for the drive and was best of the rest. MISS NATIVE LINE made a middle move then was slowly gaining ground late. EVELYN'S ESCAPADES stalked the pace then failed to respond in the drive. ROSES AND DIAMONDS gradually weakened. SWEET TRICKERY passed tiring rivals. CYMREIG raced evenly. DUKE'S VICTORY showed little. NORTH TO SOUTH chased the winner for six furlongs and faded. BRAND NEW GATOR checked after the start. MISS NATIVE LINE wore nasal strip. The portable inner rail was set out 12 feet and the quarter clocking was hand timed.
