DEBBIE'S FAST GIRL was void of early speed, angled to the outside out of the second turn then closed well outside to be up in the final strides. GUANAHANI set a solid pace, resisted gamely from the second turn on and was just caught late. TARVA raced close up from the outset, bid in the second turn then also continued well to late before being outkicked to the wire. NO ACRONYMS saved ground, got through along the rail to challenge in the drive but was outfinished late. HOMEROOM ANGEL closed a late gap outside. THE REAL FUTURE was hung five wide, bid through the second turn then came up empty. OCALA GATOR pressed the issue for seven furlongs then faded. STAR EMERALD was no factor. WEDDING DIAMOND was through after a half.
