WESTBOUND TRAIN set a solid pace, shook off a bid from NATHAN RIDGE in the turn, reopened a good lead a furlong out then held sway under pressure. GENERALISSIMO was never far back, angled outside in the drive then was up for the place late. TAXES FOR BEN angled out widest in mid stretch but offered only a mild rally late. BELLA'S FELLA pressed the pace inside early, remained close up to the final furlong but failed to respond. NATHAN RIDGE chased early, bid through the turn then slowly weakened. DIRECTION TO PAY was no factor.
