LEADING ON vied for the lead two wide from the outset, held on well when headed in the turn then came back on in the drive and proved narrowly best after a stiff duel. TONY TERRIFIC unhurried early, made a quick four wide move to challenge in the second turn and gain a short lead then also continued well through a long drive before just hanging late. CABERNEIGH angled outside into the stretch then was going well outside late. LUCKMAN made a four wide middle move then weakened. LITTLE DOVEFEATHER passed tiring rivals. DAWN RAIDER checked along inside while boxed early then came up empty. TIGANELLO (GER) raced boxed early, checked in traffic into the second turn then gave way. DULANSKY failed to menace. ROCKLANE stopped. SONG OF GREATNESS was through after a half.
