BRADY BABY broke sharp, set a fast pace under stout rating then drew off when asked after six furlongs and was ridden out to prove clearly best. FIZZY POP made a middle move after five furlongs then split rivals in the drive to be up for the place while no match for the winner. TOO MANY SINS raced close up early, bid after five furlongs but couldn't stay with the winner and weakened in the drive. JED GREELEY was well placed early then gave way. DIAMOND STEAL looped five wide through the second turn then came up empty. RARE RANSOM failed to menace. CLAXTON showed little. ALARMING AFLEET stopped. PATRICK'S TACK was through early.
