Footnotes

THUNDER BREW tracked the early pace on the rail, came through inside of rivals at the quarter pole, drove clear, lasted. GLEAM OF HOPE well back and off the rail, fanned five wide into the stretch, made a steady gain in the lane, missed. CELTIC NEW YEAR set the early pace inside, dueled through the second turn with AFRICAN MOON, shook clear of that one, could not stay with the winner and lost the place spot late. HIGH ASPIRATIONS well back and outside, gained contention through the second turn, came four wide for the drive and had a mild gain in the lane. AFRICAN MOON tracked the early pace inside, angled out to duel with the early pace setter through the second turn, weakened in the drive. TEETEE'S TAPIT showed little, inside. RICKYONTHERUN fractious in the gate, was a brief factor. BAYOU PALACE was no factor.
