BALANCE OF POWER stalked the pace early, bid three wide out of the second turn to secure a clear lead then held sway late under steady handling. SILVER DAY made a middle move to be closest to the winner into the furlong grounds but couldn't gain on that one late while outfinishing the rest. TORI'S GUY was well placed but lacked a strong late response. LILA WASHTA failed to menace. QUITE THE FACE was put in tight quarters and forced to take up into the first turn. EXACTNESS set a moderate pace then gave way. CHAZZY HUSTLE disputed the pace early then came up empty.
