ALLIE'S EVENT was unhurried early, made a middle move to challenge for and gain the lead after six furlongs then held sway under brisk handling. ADMIRAL PERRY raced boxed in traffic through the second turn then finished willingly once clear and outfinished the rest for the place. SUMMER BREEZING was pushed into the inner rail and forced to take up early, recovered to dispute the pace into the stretch then drifted out and weakened. ROYAL HILL raced close up but lacked a late response. GLOWING MONARCH failed to menace. PENN'S GRANT was no factor. PYRITE PERSONAL came in early and pushed SUJMMER BREEZING into the inner rail disputed the pace then stopped. ULTRAPASSANDO (BRZ) showed little.
