FRONTSIDE sprinted clear from the outside early, set very fast pace, drew off to mid stretch then was clearly best under steady handling. ANIME made a middle move after five furlongs and was second best. I LIKE IT saved ground to the stretch, angled to the middle of the course but failed to gain. COCO ROSE chased early, tried unsuccessfully to collar the winner after five furlongs then weakened. RARE BIT was well placed for six furlongs then gave way. GYPSY LOU was no factor. GLASS BOTTLE showed little. ZALMARA chased to the second turn then faded. CASUALLY PUT showed little. STARSHIP STREAKER failed to menace.
