CHEF'S CHOICE was unhurried for more than a half, made a quick middle move to challenge for and gain the lead out of the second turn then shook off GLITTERING LADY leaving the furlong marker and won going away while ridden out. GLITTERING LADY broke in the air at the break, recovered quickly to stalk early, drew clear into the second turn, was no match for the winner when challenged but was easily second best. WAVERING MARCI was forwardly placed but failed to respond in the drive. WATRALS DANCER passed tiring rivals. PEROXIDE LADY failed to menace. ONE UP dueled to near the second turn then weakened. TOP QUEST raced evenly. SEE U AT MY WINDOW was no factor. SOUTHERN RIDGE showed little. NICOLE'S MISSION stopped. The portable inner rail was set at zero feet.
