EVERYMAN was unhurried early, advanced into the second turn then was forced to steady and take up in traffic while blocked into the stretch, recovered to get through inside then split rivals leaving the furlong grounds to be up in the final strides. FUTURE DRAMA raced boxed inside for six furlongs, found room from between rivals to gain the lead into the stretch then continued gamely to the finish before just hanging late. POPPAS SPECIAL raced wide from the outset, looped five wide to challenge into the stretch then weakened near the finish. SO SMOOTH was in tight and shuffled back badly into the second turn then failed to fully recover. TAKMEOUTODABALGAME raced evenly. CLASSIC MOON set a solid pace to the stretch then gave way. ARMORED TRUCK chased early, bid through the second turn then flattened out. LOUIE'S VERDICT showed little. SALTY'S ACTOR was through after a half. DOMENICK'S DUNE stopped.
