KEEPING THE HONOR was unhurried early, was blocked and forced to wait for a bit in the second turn then found room between rivals to advance after five furlongs before rallying past the leader leaving the furlong grounds. GANDOLF broke alertly, set a solid pace but couldn't turn back the winner while saving the place. BABO was void of early speed, angled outside in the drive and made up some ground late. DISBELIEF closed a gap but too late. BLAZING PRIZE was well placed early, bid into the stretch then weakened. LITE UP THE STAGE was through after a half. SHILAH was no factor. EXPECT NO EQUAL showed little. KING SNAKE stopped.
