G.'S FLASH set a moderate pace into the final furlong before weakening while second best. TANGO WHISKEY pressed the issue for six furlongs then weakened. ALISA'S ENGINEER was well placed but failed to gain. ITS BUSINESS TIME was also well placed to the stretch but had no rally. OH MY GOLD raced evenly. UNFLAPABLE showed little. MALIBU MIKE was no factor. NASHVILLE stopped.
