FUNNY ANNIE chased outside early, bid after five furlongs to gain a short lead, shook off a challenge from GADOLINIUM leaving the furlong grounds then just lasted over PORTRA CLASICA late. POTRA CLASICA (ARG) was unhurried early, angled out six wide into the stretch then finished strong outside the winner to just miss. GADOLINIUM was never far back, bid outside the winner into the stretch then weakened in the final sixteenth. MEADOW SKIPPIN lodged a mild rally inside late. RUNNING LASS set a moderate pace for five furlongs then gave way. BRIGHT PYRITE was hung six wide prompting the pace to the second turn then faded. SAFFRONISTA failed to menace. FOR GILLIAN showed little. NIJINSKY BULLET was through after a half. LEONA'S KNIGHT stopped.
