JAMMIN IN THE SAND came in after the break, chased the pace early, bid three wide in the drive and rallied past the leaders leaving the furlong grounds before outfinishing AWESOME ALLEN late. AWESOME ALLEN angled out five wide in the drive then was slowly gaining outside the winner late. BLIND BET dueled past mid stretch before weakening. KIN KON was hustled along inside to duel past the furlong marker before also weakening. QUARTIER BLANC chased to the stretch then gave way. COCOA BEACH ROCKET raced evenly. FLORIDA'S QUIXOTE was shuffled back when the winner came in after the start. FIVE SPEED broke slow then raced evenly. TUNNEL VISION was no factor. PARISIAN COWBOY showed little.
