BRIGHT PYRITE broke sharp to gain a clear early lead, was unchallenged while setting the pace slightly removed from the inner rail then drew off leaving the turn and was clearly best under steady handling. MAKE IT LAST chased inside, was no match for the winner while outfinishing the rest for the place. DUCHESS D'OR split rivals in upper stretch then lodged a mild rally. SPECIAL LUCK chased into the stretch then weakened. HAPID RALO passed faders. LEGAL TESTAMONY raced evenly. VIVA LA VIDA faded after a half. GO GROOM was no factor. BABY GIN raced wide for five furlongs then came up empty. SUNRISE CURVE was no factor. ANNS GOT RYTHYM stopped.
