TRICKS OF GLORY set a solid pace from the outset, shook clear after five furlongs then prevailed under strong handling. HOLD'EM OR FOLD'EM stalked the pace early, bid after a half then came back on again late in a good effort. KENNY RUN raced close up early, bid five wide through the turn then continued to contend outside but was outkicked. SUNSATONAL passed tiring rivals. MOMENT OF SONG pressed the issue inside to the final furlong then weakened. ROTHESAY was no factor. COULD BE YOU was through after a half. GENO MADERO showed little.
