MIRACLE IN MAY was void of early speed, fanned five wide after advancing to contention then rallied outside to run down the leaders late. ROBIN DES CONCORDE made a three wide middle move, bid leaving the furlong marker but was outkicked late. PAT'S IMAGE rushed to the front early, set a solid pace, drew off to a comfortable lead a furlong out only to be caught late. JAUNTY GALE looped through the second turn then closed a gap but too late. LEAR'S LUV made up some ground late. SAMBA G steadied inside early then faded. LA DOLFINA was taken well back early then didn't enter contention. LADY MB (FR) chased early, bid leaving the second turn then flattened out. FRENCH SOCIAL checked inside while chasing the leader for six furlongs then faded. INCA IS CALLING stopped.
