BATTLE MUSIC set a solid pace, resisted gamely when challenged through a long drive then just lasted late. RYVIT stalked the pace early, bid three wide out of the second turn then was slowly getting to the winner late to just miss. FINANCIALLY SECURE raced boxed inside to mid stretch, angled outside in mid stretch for racing room then finished strong once clear. QUECHEE stalked the pace outside but lacked a strong late response. READY TO STRIKE raced evenly. ROBBIE'S EXPRESS pressed the issue for seven furlongs then gave way. TIME TRIAL failed to menace. PONZI showed little. THOR'S EGO was no factor. HOLLYWOOD HERO showed little.
