GONNA BLOW vied outside rivals early, shook clear into the second turn then continued well through the drive to hold sway under brisk handling. FAMOUS FROLIC made an inside middle move, angled off the rail in the drive but failed to gain while besting the rest. HELLCAT PILOT saved ground into the stretch but lacked a strong late response. HERE TO PLEASE checked up in traffic in the first turn, chased the leader to the stretch then weakened. WHO SLEW WHO raced evenly. SIX CROSS ROADS failed to menace. BEAU CLASSIC showed little. DEPUTY CONNOR was no factor. EL TAMPAINO was no threat. SERRA RETREAT stopped and was outdistanced.
