EXPECT VALIDITY pressed the leader from the outset, continued gamely outside that one through a long drive then was up in the final strides. WATCHTOWER (IRE) set a moderate pace, resisted the winner through a prolonged duel then just hung late. DENNIS'S DREAM made a four wide middle move, fanned five wide into the stretch to be a threat a furlong out but was outkicked late. HI POPPY made an inside middle move, got through along the rail to challenge in the furlong grounds then hung late. IRISH RED failed to menace. GRAND CANAL chased early then faded. LIQUEUR was through early.
