CHIRAC angled in early, made a middle move through the turn then bid along the rail through the furlong grounds and won going away. WOULD IF I COULD set a solid pace, drew off a bit to the stretch then weakened late while second best. ALIE'S DOUBLECROSS was well placed inside but failed to gain. BREEZE KEEPER failed to menace. CRUISIN CASINO faded after a half. PAUPER'S GOLD showed little. SETTINGSSTRAIGHT wasn't pressed in the stretch. DOUBLE DUKE stopped.
