RIGHTLY ROYAL passed tiring rivals. LOST RIVER also passed faders. FAMOUS FROLIC was well placed but had no rally. BRASSIE PRINCE was no factor. BIG JOHN G showed little. VICTORY AT MIDWAY stopped. OBERALP showed little. SIPHO stopped.
