ROMANCE INCLUDED was never far back while hustled along early, bid five wide through the furlong grounds and ran down the leader late. ON TOUR raced close up early, bid four wide in the turn to gain the lead, swerved to the inside before being steadied in the drive then hung late. PLAYDEMBONES was void of early speed then lodged a mild belated bid. QUICK N PINK passed tiring rivals. EL MEXICANO dueled three wide into the stretch then was in tight in the drive while tiring. NO PAY GEORGE raced evenly. CAN'T BUY LOVE also raced evenly. THREE ON A MATCH showed little. GOLDZAR was through after a half. STORMIN THRU dueled inside then faltered. STEEL TRAIN failed to menace. NEW YORK BOB stopped.
