### Footnotes

GOLD PAGEANTRY raced boxed in tight quarters through the second turn, angled out three wide for clear racing room then rallied past the leaders through the furlong grounds to win going away. QUISTOPHER set a solid pace, was no match for the winner when challenged then saved the place. CHIEF THIEF chased early, bid through the second turn then weakened in the drive. BEST WESTERNER was well placed inside but failed to respond. CONRAD CROSSING passed tiring rivals. LORD LOUIS raced evenly. J T KINGFISHER hopped at the break. SYNCOPATION chased to the quarter pole then faded. WILD 'N' WAKI GUY bid through the second turn then came up empty. JUDGE KELLY trailed.
