CRASH IN BOSTON chased three wide, bid leaving the turn to gain a short lead then resisted well to late before hanging. D'COFFEE CAT made a three wide middle move, bid outside in the drive to loom a threat then was outkicked late. VALUEABLE SILVER dueled inside to mid stretch before weakening. WICKLOW ROYALE raced evenly. SEAN WHO vied early then gave way. NASHVILLE was no factor. EMIL J raced far back to the stretch. COUNTY TIME stopped.
