**Footnotes**

COAHOMA hopped at the break, was unhurried for five furlongs, made a quick move to contention leaving the second turn then after gaining the lead in the furlong grounds, just lasted late. REMEMBER RED was void of early speed, made a four wide middle move to contention through the second turn then fanned outside and finished willingly to be getting to the winner late. POUNDCAKE raced wide early before tucking in behind rivals on the backstretch, angled out three wide to challenge for the lead out of the second turn then dueled past mid stretch before weakening. FALSE PROMISES was boxed through the second turn and into the stretch then lodged a mild rally. BOASTFUL angled off the rail early, rushed to the lead three wide then gave way under pressure. IRIE JUSTICE failed to menace. KING CASSIA vied for the lead to the stretch then faded. DANCE PRO was steadied along inside for a half then came up empty. SPECTACULAR DEAL was no factor. ATIBA stopped. The portable inner rail was set out 22 feet.
