VAMOS A VER chased the leader from the outset then rallied outside that one to wear DA PLANE down in the final 40 yards. DA PLANE broke sharp, set the early pace well removed from the inner rail then continued well when challenged in the drive before just hanging late. TRISTEN'S MAMBO made a middle move then bid inside in the drive but was outkicked late. THE PELOTON came in early, stalked the pace but failed to respond when asked. TEETEE'S TAPIT weakened gradually. GUIDING MISSILE was no tight and bumped with LIGHTNIN DADA early. LIGHTNIN DADA was roughed up in traffic early. FORESTRY STEEL stopped. DIAMOND LORD trailed.
