### Footnotes

EL ROMANO stalked the pace inside for six furlongs, got through along the rail to challenge in the furlong grounds then kicked free late under pressure. NORTHERN YANKEE set or pressed the pace from the outset, shook clear after six furlongs but weakened late while saving the place. MONASTIC was rank while being checked and wrangled along at the back of the pack for a half, moved up quickly from between rivals through the second turn, angled outside in the drive then was slowly gaining late. PAULISTANO set or pressed the pace for six furlongs then weakened. PATRIOTIC DREAM raced evenly. I. E. FLASH was no factor. MOROCCAN BREW chased early then gave way. BEST TRIP was through after a half.
