AWOL SOLDIER was boxed from the second turn then split rivals in the furlong grounds to be up in the final strides. ST. PATTY'S TOUR made a three wide middle move, loomed boldly down the middle of the course through the drive and just missed. PROSPECTORS STRIKE made an inside middle move, got through along the rail in mid stretch and was gaining late. SILVER ON SILVER stalked the pace outside, bid three wide after five furlongs to gain a short lead out of the second turn then also continued well to late. BAILAMOS dueled to mid stretch before giving way grudgingly. GALLOPING GOURMET raced evenly. STORMY BREW fanned six wide out of the second turn then lodged a mild late gain. YE OF LITTLE FAITH also raced evenly. BROADWAY JOHNNY pressed to the quarter pole then faded. JADE DIGGER showed little. The portable inner rail was set at 22 feet.
