Footnotes

PROFESSOR BIGGS unhurried early, made a four wide middle move to contention, went after the leader leaving the second turn then after dueling to late, proved best under strong handling. JOHNNY TORNADO had a perfect trip, sitting behind the dueling leaders, bid leaving the second turn to lead briefly then resisted the winner to late but was outfinished on the line. HE'SANOACTOR was well placed for six furlongs, angled to the middle of the course into the stretch but failed to respond when set down. GUNNING FOR was blocked in traffic for a time on the second turn then lodged a mild rally once clear. BALANCE THE BOOKS dueled inside to upper stretch then slowly gave way. DUSTYS BIRTHDAY was also well placed for five furlongs then weakened. GEBB'S FLAG showed little. ORCHARD PARK failed to menace. EXTRA COOL was no factor. SIZZLING DANCER was hard used disputing the pace and stopped. The portable inner rail was set out 22 feet.
