BLACK WILLOW was unhurried early, split rivals advancing after six furlongs then rallied past the leader leaving the furlong marker and outfinished AUNT JEN late. AUNT JEAN made a middle move, angled to the rail in the drive then finished willingly along the rail but couldn't collar the winner. KARLA'S NUMBER rushed to a long lead after three furlongs, continued well to mid stretch then weakened. DYNAMIC FEATURE made a mild middle move to the stretch then flattened out. QUIET CAY saved ground while in striking distance to the stretch but had no rally. FIVE ALARM BLAZE chased to the second turn then faded. I LOVE TO SAY YES also chased for six furlongs then came up empty. BOTTOM CLOSE showed little. MENACING MACLAYNE was no factor. MOONNATIVE stopped.
