Footnotes

OCTOBER WINDS chased the early leader, bid after six furlongs to gain a short lead then after dueling past mid stretch, shook free late under brisk handling. DEVILED SHRIMP stalked the pace for more than six furlongs, challenged outside the winner out of the second turn but weakened late while besting the rest for the place. TURN ME LOOSE made a middle move, angled to the middle of the course out of the second turn but lacked a strong late response. RARE TREASURE made a middle move to be in striking distance out of the second turn then flattened out. GRAND REVIEW was well placed for six furlongs but had no rally. OKAY RENEE failed to threaten. IRISH PRINCESS set a moderate pace for six furlongs then dropped back. ROMACA was no factor. STACK BRIDE checked up in traffic early. SHULINA hopped at the break. The portable inner rail was set out 22 feet.
