R B HIGHER GROUND chased the leader early, bid in the second turn to gain a short lead then continued gamely through a long drive and was all out to prevail. THE SPANISH LIFE was never far back, angled inside to challenge in mid stretch but was outkicked late. VOICE OF FAITH stalked the pace early, bid three wide after five furlongs and also continued well to late before hanging. SILVER TUXEDO looped five wide out of the second turn then was slowly gaining late. SUNSATONAL made up some ground laet. STEEL TRAIN saved ground but had no rally. FRIES was hard used then gave way. OAK FOREST was hung five wide chasing for six furlongs then stopped.
