BRIDLED QUEST was boxed and forced to steady along early, split rivals leaving the second turn to challenge then edged clear late after a long drive. QUITE THE GUY raced close up early, bid in the second turn to gain a short lead then resisted well when challenged to late before hanging while saving the place. FIRE STRIKER was void of early speed, split rivals in the drive to be a threat a furlong out but was outkicked late. BELLO PAPP was dueled to the furlong marker then weakened. SUNSATIONAL made an outside middle move then flattened out. WILD TURK failed to menace. SCOOTER ROACH was through after a half. TUCKLINO vied for the lead to the quarter pole then faded. SIR TYLER T stopped.
