DR. ZIC broke sharp, set a fast pace while racing well off the inner rail then drew off through the final furlong while ridden out. RISING FEVER (BRZ) stalked the pace, fanned four wide out of the turn then was up for the place late while no match for the winner. DON'TTALKTOME stalked the pace inside for five furlongs, angled off the rail attempting to get to the winner out of the turn but couldn't stay with that one and weakened late. R BETTY GRAYBULL made an outside middle move but failed to sustain that rally. MOONSHINE ALICE pressed the pace outside to the quarter pole then faded. STEP OUT SMARTLY passed tiring rivals. SECRET KIN raced evenly. CONGOTOWN failed to menace. PAY THE MAN was through early. TRAINEE trailed.
