### Footnotes

LIVIN LARGE sprinted clear early, set a solid pace, drew off a bit after six furlongs then lasted late after bearing out badly crossing the chute. CONRAD CROSSING was void of early speed, split rivals in the drive and was gaining late inside. CANDY TRAIN raced close up to be in striking distance into the furlong grounds but failed to gain late. BATON ON FIRE chased the winner into the stretch then weakened. TOP DOG raced evenly. HIGH ASPIRATIONS passed tiring rivals. CERTAIN APPEAL was restless in the gate then broke slow. DONTLAFFHESPAIDFOR made a wide middle move then came up empty. DIRECTION TO PAY chased to the stretch then faded. ALL THE BASES was in motion at the start, raced well placed to the second turn then stopped.
