ENDER'S SISTER broke sharp then was eased back off the early pace, angled off the rail out out of the second turn then wore down MENIFEEQUE in the late stages under strong left hand pressure. MENIFEEQUE was never far back, bid three wide into the second turn, drew off a bit after six furlongs then just hung late while best of the rest. AMERICA AMERICA was void of speed for five furlongs, advanced inside through the second turn but couldn't gain on the top two late. GOLD GINNY was well placed but lacked a strong late response. FALL FASHION moved clear into the backstretch, set a moderate pace under good handling then resisted well to mid stretch before weakening. SISTI'S PRIDE stalked for six furlongs then came up empty. HELLO GITANA failed to menace. LADYINAREDDRESS was in tight between rivals at the quarter pole then faded. CHANCEY LIGHT stopped.
