Footnotes

UNO CHAPO made a middle move through the turn, fanned four wide out of the second turn then after rallying past the leaders to gain the lead, lasted late. CHIP HUNTER was unhurried early, got through along the inside in the drive then finished well late inside. EIGHTEENTHOFMARCH was void of early speed, fanned six wide out of the second turn then was going well late outside. BALLAST (IRE) was blocked through the second turn, swung three wide to challenge into the stretch but was outkicked late. HUNTING PRINT stalked the pace, bid three wide in the second turn then weakened. EL POPPIE chased early, bid in the second turn then flattened out. SIR RABBIT was no factor. LIGHTNING POWER showed little. WILLSBORO POINT was no factor. KINGSDALE OCEAN (IRE) stopped.
