MOMENT OF SONG dueled for five furlongs, drew off out of the turn to mid stretch then was kept to strong pressure to hold a safe margin. ROYAL INTENT dueled inside to the stretch, was no match for the winner but was best of the rest. UNCLE BILL angled outside and lodged a mild rally. LOST HER AT DAWN chased to upper stretch then weakened. ZULU raced evenly. SHAGTIME PAULY was shuffled back from between rivals early and faded after five furlongs. R. G. CAMPBELL was no factor. FAMILY MONEY was through early. FARM SAVER failed to menace. OUR FIRST FLIGHT showed little.
