

**TAMPA BAY DOWNS - March 15, 2008 - Race 12**

STAKES Tampa Bay Derby Grade 3 - Thoroughbred



FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$150 each which should accompany the nomination, \$1,250 to pass the entry box and \$1,750 additional to start with \$300,000 guaranteed. With 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$90,000 at one mile or over, 2 lbs.; \$60,000 at one mile or over since January 1, 2008, 4 lbs.; \$50,000 at one mile or over, 6 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters and riders to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This field will be limited to twelve starters. In the event more than twelve pass through the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined with preference given to Grade I, II or III Stakes winners in that order, then those that have accumulated the highest career earnings. For those that enter and are eliminated under these conditions, the nomination and entry fees will be refunded. SUPPLEMENTARY NOMINATIONS OF \$7,500 EACH (which include the entry and starting fees), CLOSE THURSDAY, MARCH 13, 2008 BY THE USUAL TIME OF CLOSING. CLOSED SATURDAY, MARCH 1, 2008 WITH 20 NOMINATIONS AND 1 SUPPLEMENT.

BIG TRUCK was well placed behind the first flight for more than five furlongs, angled out four wide into the stretch while rallying then ran down ATONED in the final 40 yards under strong handling. ATONED was six wide on the backstretch, bid four wide into the stretch, shook clear in the furlong grounds then just hung late while second best. DYNAMIC WAYNE was void of early speed, fanned five wide into the stretch to be in striking position but weakened in the final furlong. MAKE ME ZACH came in at the break, dueled for six furlongs then gave way in the drive. CIGAR MAN saved ground from the outset, was in tight quarters into the stretch then gave way. GENTLEMAN JAMES bumped with WAR PASS at the break then again shortly thereafter, dueled for six furlongs then stopped. WAR PASS was restless in the gate then was bumped at the start by MAKE ME ZACH and GENTLEMAN JAMES then shortly thereafter by GENTLEMAN JAMES, was hustled along to hold a striking position while five wide then stopped and was not pressed in the stretch. A claim of foul by the rider of CIGAR MAN against MAKE ME ZACH for interference into the stretch was disallowed.
