KOKANEE KID chased outside, bid three wide on the turn and drew clear under urging. WOKEUPONHOMEPLATE chased inside, bid on the rail entering the stretch and came up second best. PLATINUM SANDY bobbled and was bumped at the break, raced off the rail, four wide on the turn, came wide into the stretch and gained mildly outside. ROJOTHEMAGNIFICO raced inside, was steadied past the half mile marker, then failed to threaten. MY PRIZE NOW saved ground, came four wide into the lane and lacked a rally. FRANCIS MARION chased between foes and tired. KRIS KRINGLE did not factor. QUETZALITO broke outward, set the pace and gave way. DUCKLUND was outrun.
