SKY TOWN raced off the pace inside, angled out at the top of the lane, closed well outside and got the nod on the wire. BR. ALEXANDER stalked the pacesetter, moved up between rivals, bid between foes passing the quarter pole, dug in gamely inside, led late and just missed. DRINK OR SINK was fractious in the gate, chased outside, bid three wide at the quarter pole and was outkicked. MORE ZEN TEA saved ground racing off the pace, was steadied in tight along the rail in upper stretch, angled out and rallied. CALIPARI set the pace, dug in when challenged and weakened. WICKLOW failed to threaten. MYLES raced off the rail and tired. CONCERT DELL was outrun. WHITE HILL was off slowly and showed little.
