Footnotes

GATE'S GOLD was void of early speed, made an inside middle move then got through into the stretch then after gaining a short lead in the furlong grounds, was all out to prevail over KEYANO. KEYANO also made a middle move, was in tight and forced to steady between rivals in upper stretch, found room in the furlong grounds then finished willingly to just miss. SWANKY MODE rushed to the lead inside early, dueled to mid stretch then gave way late. HALL OF POWER stalked the pace outside, bid into the stretch then faltered in the final furlong. OAK SPRINGS ACE was through early in a dull effort. PRINCE SKIF chased the leader, bid at the quarter pole, was bumped in the drive then came up empty. THUNDERING STORM stalked the pace for six furlongs, attempted to go into a narrow opening between horses in upper stretch but lacked sufficient racing room, had to steady then drifted over the heels of a rival, clipped those and bobbled badly, unseating his rider. A stewards inquiry was held before the race was declared official.
