SWEETEST SECRET stalked the pace inside for six furlongs, angled outside for the drive then rallied past HOT RHYTHM through the furlong grounds and drew off while ridden out. HOT RHYTHM sprinted clear early, set a moderate pace under good handling but was no match for the winner when challenged while clearly second best. ROBIN IN SPRING made a middle move, fanned five wide for the drive but failed to gain. GINGER SPIN made a middle move on the second turn but failed to sustain that bid. RUPERT'S APPROVAL raced evenly. BLACK SERAPHIM failed to menace. GROOVY DOO chased for six furlongs and faded. SMOKIN JEN was through after a half. ESTHER'S PIC showed little then pulled up in distress. LUCKIEST HALO was no factor. The portable rail was set out 12 feet.
