Footnotes

EQUALITY broke a half step slow, recovered to quickly move up outside horses into the first turn to prompt the pace under snug restraint, moved to a clear lead after five furlongs without need of strong urging then was roused in the final furlong to maintain a safe margin late. TAILS OF THE CRYPT was unhurried early, made a three wide middle move after five furlongs and finished well but was no match for the winner. POLITICAL ATTACK broke sharp to gain the early lead, succumbed readily when challenged by the winner on the second turn, remained close up to the late stages then weakened. MUCHO RAPIDO made a middle move to the quarter pole but failed to sustain that rally. BUNK N TED, washy in the post parade, made a mild middle move after five furlongs but came up empty. INAUGURAL ADDRESS failed to menace. OUR BUCK was shuffled back from between rivals in the first turn then faded after three furlongs. FINAL PROPHECY stopped after a half. SHOWMEITALL also stopped after a half mile.
