JAVA WIT raced outside rivals from the outset, bid out of the second turn to gain a clear lead then was under brisk handling to prevail late. PRETTY GALORE was void of early speed, made a four wide middle move to contention, drifted out leaving the second turn then was slowly gaining outside the winner late. GIRLISH GIGGLE also made a middle move then angled to the inside in the drive and was also slowly gaining. CALL FROM THE BAR chased for six furlongs but failed to respond. PICTURESOFMEMORIES raced evenly. MISS OOH LA LA set a moderate pace for more than six furlongs then gave way. HALO'S WILDCAT chased to the second turn then faded.
