BOUNTIFUL STAR gained command at the start, let throughout in a perfect trip, won driving. SUMMERHILL GAL showed good speed from the outset, chased the winner throughout, gaining late. POPPA'S IRISH LADY was always well placed, chased the pace, commenced a bid in the stretch and finished well. ROAN EXPRESS was unhurried early, steadily advanced, closed a late gap. TILLTHELASTDOGDIES broke alertly, prompted the pace into the stretch and tired. SO CLASSIC was always in contention, an even effort, failed to sustain a bid. KNIGHT MISTRESS was void of speed and only passed tiring rivals. RITZEE ROYAL CROWN showed no speed and was never close. CRYPTONESIAN settled off the pace and lacked any late response. VINTAGE PRIDE (IRE) was through early and was never a factor.
