Footnotes

EUROPASS stalked the pace inside for five furlongs, found room along the rail while challenging in the furlong grounds and was all fully extended to outfinish DASH ON HOLME. DASH ON HOLME ivied for the lead from the outset, held on well when headed then came on again late inside in a good effort. NIGHT OF DELIGHT made an inside middle move, got through in mid stretch and was gaining ground late. SWEET SINGING SAMI looped rivals five wide through the turn, fanned six wide into the stretch then weakened in the final furlong. TWISTINGANDTURNING pressed the pace to upper stretch then weakened. WHAT'SUPWITHTHAT made a middle move then gave way. COLUMBIAN CAT was hard used disputing the pace to the quarter pole then stopped.
